Reminders

Please provide snack, separate from lunch, and place it in a bag which we will send back to you to re-use or a tub with your child's name on. When we have apples, plums and so on not in a bag/tub with no name we do not know who the snack belongs to.

Please can you write or label your child's water bottles, again if we have 2 bottles that are the same, we do not know who to give the bottle to.

Please can you provide a bucket/legionnaire/wide brimmed hat and not a baseball cap for their sun hat. Sun Cream must be applied before coming to Pre-School and be available in their bags to reapply.

We have started something new for this year and this is for the children to have their own learning journal for them to put their own work in.
